ARC's Commission meet two times a month to review applications and award selected credentials. Please allow 2-4 weeks, for the commission to meet and review your application. Once it has been reviewed and either confirmed or postponed, you will receive an email regarding the next steps.

What does your credential receive?

1. National recognition for your dedicated work to the special operations profession. You will be placed in the database for members and visitors to view, when they access our page.
2. Certificate of Credential, to show your family, friends, and colleagues. This will be mailed to your address.
3. Uniform rocker that signifies your level of credential. (Extra rockers can be bought in the member store, by members only)
4. Access to ARC Online, which provides members with 100's of hours of instruction on new tactics, training scenario's, and yearly in-service for hazmat recertification.
5. ARC Challenge Coin. (Extra coins can be bought in the member store, by members only)
